John 13:1-2 (NIV) *“It was just before the Passover Festival. Jesus knew that the hour had come for Him to leave this world and go to the Father. Having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end. ² The evening meal was in progress, and the devil had already prompted Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot, to betray Jesus.”*

Jesus Is In The Last Week Of His Life On Earth...

On Monday...

Matthew 21:12-13 (NIV) *“Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. ¹³ ‘It is written,’ He said to them, ‘My house will be called a house of prayer,’ but you are making it ‘a den of robbers.’”*

On Tuesday...

Matthew 21:23 (NIV) *“Jesus entered the temple courts, and, while He was teaching, the chief priests and the elders of the people came to Him. ‘By what authority are You doing these things?’ they asked. ‘And who gave You this authority?’”*

Matthew 23:13 (NIV) *“Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites!”*

On Thursday night...

Luke 22:24 (NIV) *“A dispute also arose among them as to which of them was considered to be greatest.”*

Mark 9:35 (NIV) *“Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, ‘Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all.’”*

Mark 10:45 (NIV) *“For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.”*

John 13:3-5 (NIV) *“Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under His power, and that He had come from God and was returning to God; ⁴ so He got up from the meal, took off His outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around His waist. ⁵ After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash His disciples’ feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around Him.”*
