MERCY FORGIVES The Miracle of Mercy – Part 4 May 7, 2017

Matthew 6:12 (NLT) "Forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us."

Mercy: unearned kindness & undeserved forgiveness

1. Mercy means God forgives you.

Four Truths About God's Forgiveness...

God <u>wants</u> to forgive you.

Nehemiah 9:17b (**TLB**) "But You are a God of forgiveness, always ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to become angry, and full of love and mercy."

Micah 7:18b (NIV) "You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy."

• God <u>freely</u> forgives you.

Romans 3:23-24 (TLB) "Yes, all have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious ideal; ²⁴ yet now God declares us 'not guilty' of offending Him if we trust in Jesus Christ, who in His kindness freely takes away our sins."

• God immediately forgives you.

Isaiah 55:7 (GNT) "Let the wicked leave their way of life and change their way of thinking. Let them turn to the Lord, our God; He is merciful and quick to forgive."

• God completely forgives you.

Colossians 2:13-14 (NLT) "You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for He forgave all our sins. ¹⁴ He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross."

Micah 7:19 (NCV) "You will have mercy on us again; You will conquer our sins. You will throw away all our sins into the deepest part of the sea."

Romans 8:1 (NIV) "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

James 2:13b (NIV) "Mercy triumphs over judgment."

Four Truths About Forgiving Others...

• Forgiveness is not <u>conditional</u>.

Ephesians 4:32 (NIV) "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

- Forgiveness is not <u>forgetting</u>.
- **2 Timothy 4:14 (NIV)** "Alexander the metalworker did me a great deal of harm. The Lord will repay him for what he has done."
 - Forgiveness is not <u>trusting</u> the person again.
- **2 Timothy 4:15 (NIV)** "You too should be on your guard against him, because he strongly opposed our message."

Forgiveness is immediate.

Trust has to be earned over <u>time</u>.

• Forgiveness IS <u>releasing</u> it to God.

Colossians 3:13 (NLT) "Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others."
